Scope of Work:

Supply and installation of (5) Open-Air Pole Barn Picnic Shelters:

- (2) 30' x 30': Green Street Sports Complex and Withlachoochee Park
- (1) 30' x 40': Grice's Recreation Center
- (2) 20' x 30': Green Street Sports Complex

The contractor will be responsible for all site preparation, including any necessary grading and installing concrete foundations to support the pole barn structures.

The shelters will be constructed using steel trusses rated for 150 - 170mph wind load, 6x6x16 posts and 2x6 yellow pine roof purlins, a 40-year warranty metal roof with a color to match existing roof covers, and durable, weather-resistant materials suitable for the outdoor environment. The contractor will ensure the shelters meet all safety, structural, and aesthetic standards.

Upon completion, the contractor will ensure the sites are properly cleaned and prepared for public use.

Contractor Requirements:

The successful contractor will be responsible for all aspects of the project, including obtaining necessary permits, providing materials, labor, and equipment, and completing the work in a timely manner. All structures must comply with federal, state, and local building codes and safety standards. The contractor must provide proof of general liability and workers' compensation insurance.
