The tunnel package must include, but is not limited to, the following equipment:

(2) Batting Cages/Tunnels: The cages must be 14 feet in height, 14 feet in width, and 70 feet in length, designed for both pitching and batting practice in a variety of indoor settings. The cages must be durable and capable of withstanding regular use by players of various skill levels.

Padded Turf for Tunnel Length (70ft): High-quality padded turf, 15 feet in width, designed to protect both the tunnel structure and athletes. The turf should be durable enough for extensive use while providing proper footing and comfort for users.

Batting Pads: Two (2) batting pads designed to protect the athletes during practice sessions. The pads should be designed to withstand impact and provide ample cushioning while remaining easy to install and remove.

Protective "L" Screens for Baseball: Two (2) protective "L" screens for baseball, designed to protect pitchers and coaches during batting practice. The screens must be made of high-quality, durable materials to ensure safety and longevity.

Protective Screens for Softball: Two (2) protective screens for softball, built to offer the same level of protection and durability as the baseball screens. These screens must be suitable for softball pitching and batting practices.

Pitching Pads: Two (2) pitching pads for baseball and softball to provide a safe and effective surface for pitchers during practice sessions. The pads should be designed to absorb impact and protect the playing surface.

Suspension Kits to Hang Cages (Ceiling Mount): Two (2) suspension kits designed for securely hanging the batting cages from the facility's ceiling. The kits must be engineered for safety and ease of installation.

Bids must include itemized costs and a total price for all supplies and equipment, including any applicable taxes and delivery fees, manufacturer names, and warranty details.
